For Jewish women, Rosh Chodesh, the 1st day of the new month, is like a semiholiday. "Why?" you ask? Short story: because it is a reward for not being willing to participate in the sin of the Golden calf! We refused to give up our jewelry (as the men had asked) to make the idol. We had faith in God & in His servant Moses. (Pirkei d'Rabbi Eliezer, 45).

Because of our faith, we were given an extra holiday each month to abstain from forms of tedious work (laundry, sewing, farming, etc.) or from working altogether. Some communities come together to pray the Tehillim of the day (done only in daytime), pray 1/2 the Hallel (done during morning Shacharit), study Torah, have a festive meal, or wear new clothes (that one can get expensive haha!). If you don't have a custom, you can start your own! There are lots of things we can do to make Rosh Chodesh special; one of my personal favorites is to make a special dessert.

In addition, according to Kabbalistic teachings, we have a special connection to the moon: both having "cycles" of renewal. They frequently liken the moon to the "Shekhinah" (the Divine Presence) which is considered the feminine aspect of God, giving us more reason to celebrate!

For our Sisterhood, it is my goal to start our own Rosh Chodesh custom. Each

month, I'd like to share (via email to read at your own convenience) a story about the life of one "Woman of Valor" that we can remember/learn about together. From the Biblical to the modern era, we have so many extraordinary, strong, intelligent, & resilient women in our Jewish tradition, that it would take a lifetime to accomplish, but we can try & scratch the surface! So, keep an eye out each Rosh Chodesh for that!


It's my personal goal to start reading the "Rosh Chodesh" prayer each month. It takes about 5 minutes, & I feel that is a reasonable goal that I could stick to in my busy schedule.

If you are interested in doing the same, I invite you to join me via Zoom (or in my home) for 1/2 an hour each Rosh Chodesh for "Tea & Tehillim". After we read the prayer(s), we can nosh & chat about that month's "Woman of Valor", women's issues, or anything else you'd like!

As you are aware, Rosh Chodesh doesn't land on the same day each month. So, if it lands on a weekday, we will likely meet for 1/2 an hour on Rosh Chodesh Eve around 6:00 pm on Zoom. If it lands on a Sunday, we could have a brunch in the morning (at my home, during Sunday school) which allows for a few more Tehillim to be read and time to shmooze (unless a board meeting lands on that day). And if it lands on Shabbat, then the Hallel & other Tehillim will be included during Shacharit services, & we can stay after for Tea & Shabbat lunch!

Since Rosh Hashanah IS the Rosh Chodesh of Tishrei beginning our new year with plenty of prayers and activities, we will start "Tea & Tehillim" officially in October for Rosh Chodesh Cheshvan (Sunday, Oct. 15th) at 6:00 p.m. on Zoom! (There's a board meeting, so no brunch this time).

Please let me know if you'd like to participate next month & I'll get the tea ready.






